Directions to Bayou Grande Marina from NAS entrance:

LOCATION BY LAND: From the main gate entrance (Warrington) proceed left at the fork. Continue until you reach the Pen-Air Federal Credit Union. Turn left and follow the road to the end.

LOCATION BY SEA: The marina is located at the northwest corner of Pensacola Bay (see NOAA chart #11378) and monitors VHF channel 16. The well-marked marina entrance channel has a maintained depth of 8' to 13' with channel markings from #1 to #13.

The GPS coordinates for the #1 four second flashing green dayboard are latitude 30°22'.23" north and longitude 87°15'.40" west.

All owners of both Cape Dory and Robinhood power and sailboats, CDSOA members and non-members, are welcome to attend.

All captains are responsible for their own navigation and the safety of their vessels and crew.
