On the weekend of June 8-10, 2018 sailors will travel to the small town of Irvington, VA from as far away as Portland, ME, Syracuse, NY and Muskegon, MI to compete in the *5th National Typhoon Championship Regatta*. This event is the largest gathering of Cape Dory Typhoons in the world and is hosted by the Rappahannock River Yacht Club ("RRYC").

Captain Jim Key who sails *Key to Happiness* is coming for his 4th time making the 815 mile, 12+ hour trek from Michigan. He says "it's all worth it to sail with such great people in a great little yacht". The Typhoon Regatta is the perfect event for experienced racers as well as first time racers. The Champion Fleet attracts the competitive racers and the Corinthian Fleet is designed specifically for those who may have never raced before or who just want to get out and have fun.



Any sailor who needs assistance bringing his or her Typhoon from afar, RRYC sailors are on standby ready to help. Overnight accommodations are available through RRYC host families who are opening their homes to out-of-town participants.

The Rappahannock is home to the world's largest fleet of Cape Dory Typhoon sailboats. Over the past 20 years the number of Typhoons has exploded to 50 boats on Carter's Creek in Irvington, VA

and another 20 boats on nearby creeks and rivers. In 2011, RRYC founded the Cape Dory Typhoon National Championship Regatta which takes place every other year. Throughout the year, RRYC hosts weekly Wednesday night races during the Spring and Fall sailing season and several other sailing events during the course of a typical year.

Join in the regatta or just watch the races from your own boat.
