

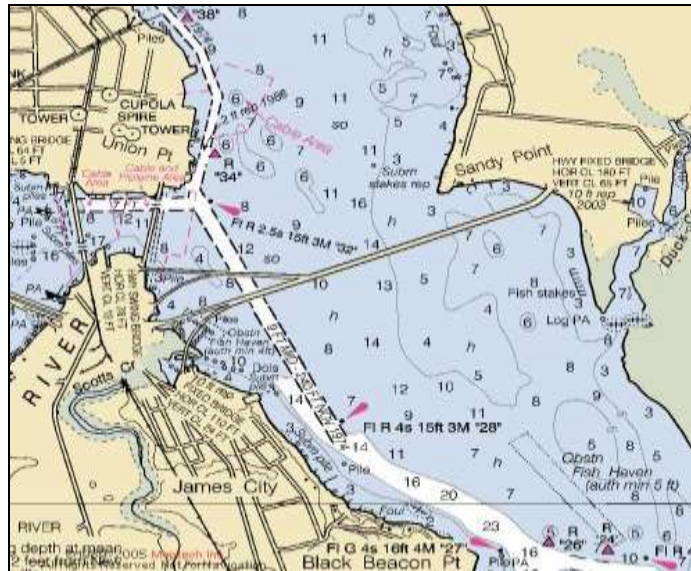

The Carolinas Fleet of the CDSOA, Inc. is hosting a "Float-in" in New Bern, NC, which will take place Sept. 17-19, 2010. The theme of the float-in is "New Bern's 300th Anniversary Jubilee Weekend".

Plans are to rendezvous in New Bern on either 9/16 or 9/17. The main departure location will be Oriental, NC. From there, we will sail/motor up the Neuse River to New Bern. Ref. the "Mini" section of NOAA Chart 11552 below for navigation details of the Neuse River just off New Bern.

**Fleet communications will be on VHF Ch. 16 and 72
for hailing and followup conversation respectively.
Please monitor these channels during the Float-in.
Hail the "Cape Dory Fleet" or individual boats.**

I have informed the **Galley Marina** (252-633-4648) of our fleet's plan for the weekend, but you must make your own reservations. Current plans are to berth at the Galley Marina, located just north of the new Cunningham Draw Bridge to **port of R34**. An alternate berthing location is the **New Bern Grand Marina** (252-638-0318), to starboard, just inside the draw bridge. Both marinas are within walking distance of all of the weekend activities which include:

- Thu. **9/16** - Trent River Flotilla, starting at 2030 hrs from the East Carolina Yacht Club
- Fri. **9/17** - The NC Symphony Orchestra 300th Tribute Concert at Tryon Palace, 1830-2000 hrs, and it's free!
 - Jubilee Fireworks, on the South lawn of Tryon Palace after the concert
- Sat. **9/18** - Heritage Parade starting at 1000 hrs from Lawson Creek Park to downtown
 - "Many Cultures Street Festival" at Union Point Park from 1200 – 1700 hrs

- A fleet dinner is planned, at Morgan's Restaurant, with seating at 1830 hrs.
- Cocktails aboard Chip and Lynne Rice's M/V *Coral Sea* prior to dinner. **B.Y.O.B. and be present for special gifts and door prizes!!!**
- Sun. **9/19** - 0700-1000 hrs. A free "Pancakes in the Park" breakfast at Union Point Park, hosted by the New Bern Council of Churches
- Public concerts, throughout the weekend, at various locations in downtown New Bern
