We will be returning to **River Dunes** [<http://www.riverdunes.com/>] this year on June 19th and 20th. The plan is to depart Oriental Saturday morning at around 0800 or whenever you would like. No real rush because it is only approximately 6 nm to the entrance to Broad Creek from Garbacon Shoals "7".

I have informed River Dunes of our fleet plan for the weekend but you must make your own reservation. Call the harbor master JC at **1-800-348-7618** to reserve a slip. On arrival, you can reach them on **VHF 16/72**.

Our plan for Saturday night is to have dinner in the restaurant at about 1900 and meet downstairs in the club house an hour prior for drinks (BYOB). Please bring an appetizer to share. I will make the dinner reservations for our group. Also, all the facilities are at our disposal, so bring your swim suits. Departing on Sunday is up to each skipper.

## Float Plan:


From Garbacon "7" set a course of 068 degrees M for 5.7nm to Gum Thicket "6". Turn to port and set a course of 344 degrees M to Broad Creek "1" which is 1.8nm. Follow the Broad Creek markers to R "4". The entrance to Grace Harbor Channel is directly to port. Broad Creek tends to quite shallow so proceed with caution and closely follow the channel markers.

Garbacon "7" -- 35 00.5 N 076 39.64 W  
Gum Thicket "6" -- 35 00.5 N 076 39.64 W  
Broad Creek "1" -- 35 05.3 N 076 35.00 W

Please confirm you plan to attend so I can make the needed dinner reservations.
