



Campbell Creek



Day 1, Sat. -- 10/8: Leave Oriental, NC at 0800 hrs for anchorage in Campbell Creek located just North of St M 155 at the Southern entrance to Goose Creek. (approx. dist. 24 N Mi)

Bath Creek



Day 2, Sun. -- Onward to Bath, NC on the Pamlico River. This will also be an anchorage. There are some old docks for the dinghies. Relax and walk the town (small) over to the park. (approx. dist. 17 N Mi)

Upper Dowry Creek




Days 3&4, Mon.-Tues. -- Off to Upper Dowry Creek just past Belhaven on the Pungo River. Tie up at the marina -- pool, ice up, loner car to Belhaven for groceries, and relax for two nights. Did I mention the pool? May be cool in Oct.! (approx. dist. 27 N Mi). *Contact Dowry Creek Marina at 800-824-7035 for reservations.*

Swan Point, Rose Bay



Day 5, Wed. -- Head back west and south to the Pamlico River, then east to Rose Bay, Swan Pt. This anchorage is in the back area of Swanquarter. Get the dinghies out and check out Judith Marsh. (approx. dist. 18 N Mi)

Ocracoke



Day 6, Thurs. --Enough of this gunkholing....leave for Ocracoke by way of Pamlico River past Middle Ground.
(approx. dist. 28 N Mi)

Days 7&8, Fri.-Sat. -- Relax at the docks, visit Ocracoke Village, take a shower, have a libation or two, compare pictures and socialize.

If we leave on Saturday 10/8, this should put us in Ocracoke on Thursday 10/13. Friday and Saturday relax and let everyone leave Sunday or earlier for their respective home ports.

Sunday departure times will be at the discretion of the various Captains. The decision to depart as a "Fleet" will be discussed over libations.

This is a tentative itinerary. As the cruise progresses, adjustments may be made due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances. Join the fleet along the way, if your time is limited.

Please contact Capt. Dick or Capt. Hilco and let us know if you plan on joining in on the fun so we will know how many boats to be on the lookout for.
