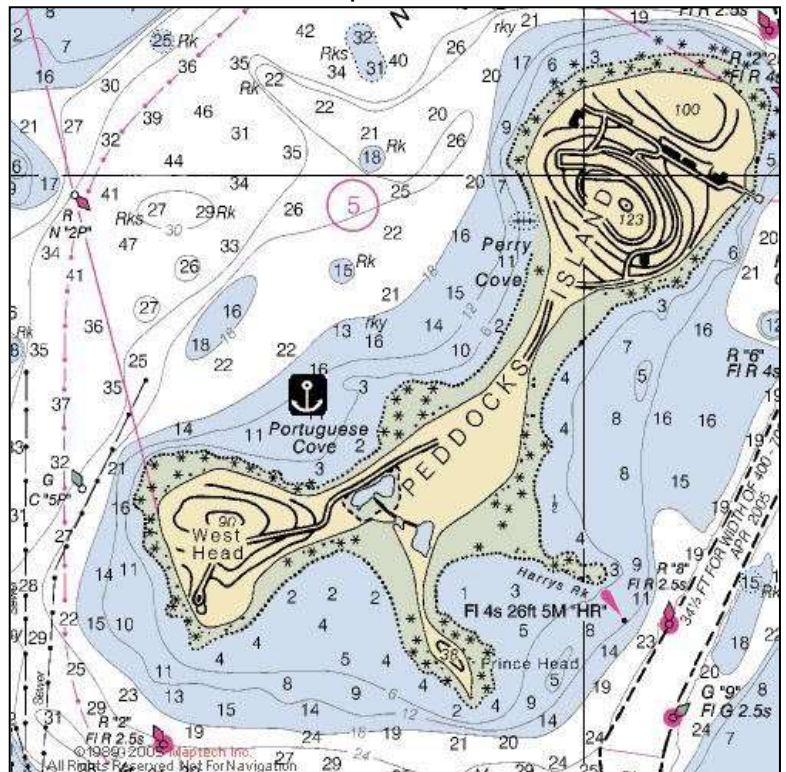

The Boston Harbor Island Regatta attracts over 100 boats that race a 13 mile, figure eight course around Boston's outer harbor and the Boston Harbor Islands. Participants include sailors of all skill levels. Trophies abound. In addition to the various fleet and other awards, three boats of the same design will be designated a Class and race for a trophy. Cape Dory race participants sailing in from out of town have informally met up at Peddocks Island for a float-in the night before the race -- with prevailing winds, usually in Portuguese Cove. You can anchor there (see the chartlet at right) or moorings are available for a fee. No reservations required.
