



CDSOA Northeast Fleet Stonington Float-In



We will either picnic in a small park across the street from Dodson Boatyard, or make reservations at a local restaurant. Contact Event Organizer Sally Perreten to let her know which you prefer, and the majority will rule. We can either meet for drinks in the little park, or a couple of boats can raft-up and play host. We sail a Typhoon, so we won't volunteer *Echo*. Let's make it 5 PM for drinks/snacks and think about eating at 6:30.



You can anchor behind the breakwater in Stonington, or in the anchorage area. Or you can book a mooring for the night from **Dodson Boatyard 860-535-1507**. Reservations are a must. They run a launch which can be called on **VHF Ch 78**. There are showers and laundry facilities at the boatyard. The town of Stonington is a delight to wander through.

**Fleet communications will be on VHF Ch. 79. Please monitor this channel during the float-in.

July 25th at noon the harbor will be very festive for the blessing of the fleet, the fleet being the last fishing fleet in the state, we believe. Following this you might like to go around the corner to Napatree. (Follow the channel behind Sandy Point and go all the way around. We have found the best holding ground at the west end of the anchorage area. Dinghy ashore or walk on the paths over the dunes to the ocean side beach -- a lovely spot that is lumpy in a strong northerly wind.

On your way to Stonington on the 24th you might want to take in the Mystic Seaport Antique & Classic Boat Rendezvous.

When you register I'll give you my cell phone number, and we will monitor VHF Ch 79 that afternoon.
