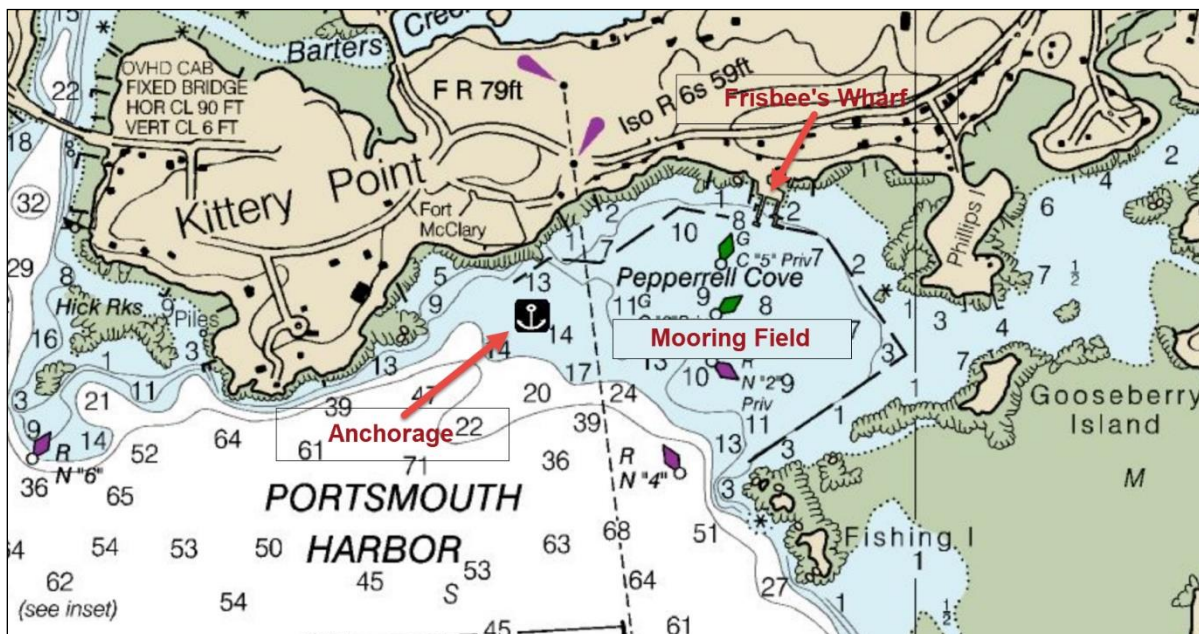
Please join us on August 21st for an evening of camaraderie in Pepperrell Cove, the first port of call, in Maine's first town, located on the north shore of the Piscataqua River in Portsmouth Harbor. It'll be a good opportunity to meet up with old friends and make a few new ones.

There are strong currents on the Piscataqua River averaging 3 knots on the flood and 5 knots on the ebb so try to plan your arrival with slack water or when you can travel with the current.

Saturday, 8/21 –Frisbee's Wharf, Kittery Point, ME

Plan on meeting in the late afternoon on Saturday, August 21st, in **Pepperrell Cove**. It offers transient moorings, available from the **Harbormaster** (VHF CH. 68. Ph: 207-451-0829), public restrooms (no showers), superb scenery, restaurants, a post office, and general store (called Provisions) right at the town dock. Dockage and moorings may also be available from **Frisbee's Wharf** (Ph: 207-703-2028). Frisbee's has showers and laundry facilities available for a fee. There is an Anchorage with good holding in mud (some rocks) just outside the mooring area toward Ft. McClary (see chartlet below).

If yours is the first boat to arrive at Pepperrell Cove, please hail the "**Cape Dory Fleet**" (VHF Ch. 16 then **78**) and let the others know that you're there. Anyone within earshot should reply with their ETAs.

We will be having a BYO snacks and beverages “dinghy float” get-together, which we’ll try to get started at around 3:30 PM, for the boats and crews that arrive early, and end around 5:00. If you don’t have a dinghy, one of the crews will pick you up in theirs. Afterwards we’ll meet ashore at **Frisbee’s Wharf** at 5:30 PM for dinner on the wharf (they close at 7:00 PM). We’ll be ordering from the menu. If it’s raining, **Bistro 1828** is Plan B.

If you get a chance on Sunday, be sure to stroll through **Fort McClary State Historic Site** located near to and west of the wharf. It can be seen from the mooring field.
