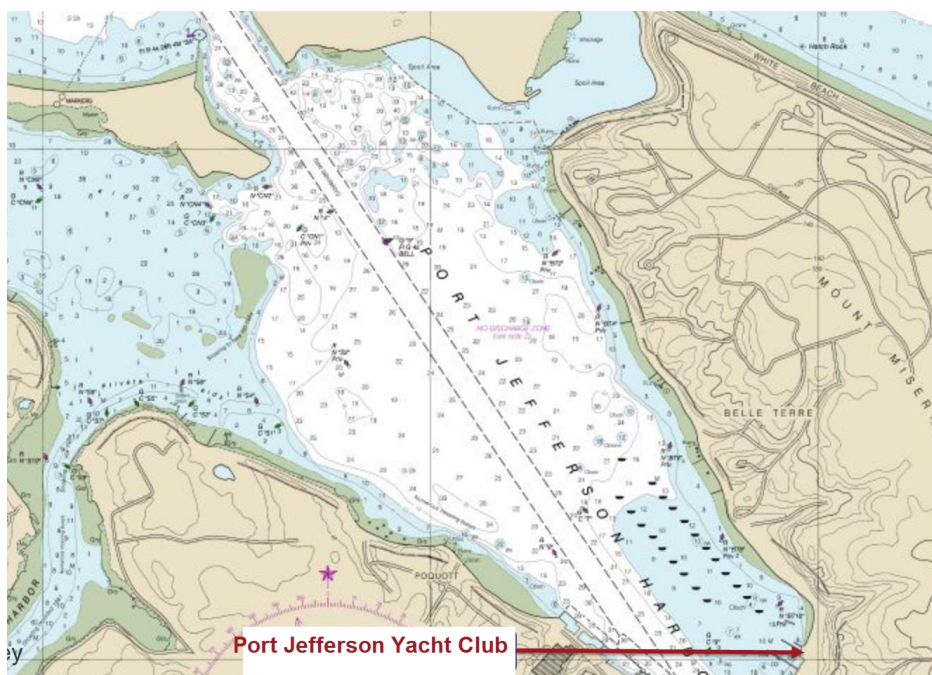

If yours is the first boat to arrive at Port Jefferson, please hail the "**Cape Dory Fleet**" (VHF Ch. 16 then **78**) and let the others know that you're there. Anyone within earshot should reply with their ETAs.

We will be having a BYO snacks and beverages "**dinghy float**" get-together which we'll try to get started at around 3:30 p.m., for the boats and crews that arrive early, and end around 4:30. Don't worry, if you don't have a dinghy, one of the crews will pick you up in theirs. Afterwards we'll meet ashore at the yacht club at 6:00 p.m. for a potluck dinner.

Your potluck entrée or side should be enough to feed about 6 to 8 people, so keep that in mind when provisioning. Don't worry, with all the crews contributing, we will have plenty of food. We will provide the plates, cups, napkins and plastic utensils. The yacht club does have a few gas grills if you need to use one.

If you get a chance on Sunday, be sure to stroll through **Harborfront Park** located very near to the yacht club. It's a little less than a half mile's walk from the yacht club to the **Mather House Museum**, at 115 Prospect Street, open on weekends from noon-4 PM. And if you like craft beer, you'll find the **Port Jeff Brewing Co.** at 22 Mill Creek Rd, also a little less than a half mile from the yacht club.
